

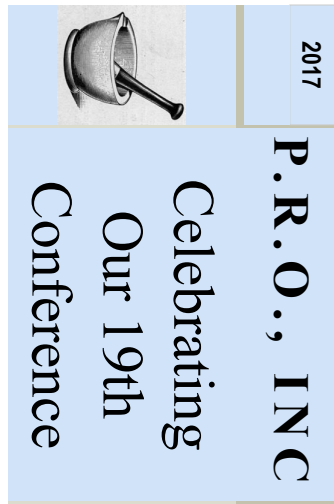

Kyle W. Parker, R.Ph, M.B.A Mr. Parker completed his B.S. Pharmacy degree from Ohio Northern University in 1993 and his Master's in Business Administration degree from Thomas More College in 2001. Mr. Parker currently is a hospital pharmacist at Knox County Memorial Hospital, teaches pharmacy law at Ohio Northern University and is a consultant, advising on regulatory and leadership issues. Previously he served as the Executive Director of the Ohio State Board of Pharmacy. Mr. Parker lectures to health professionals, Universities and associations on compliance with Ohio and Federal drug law.

Darryl S. Inaba, PharmD, CATC V, CADC III is currently the Director of Clinical and Behavioral Health Service, Addictions Recovery Center, Medford Oregon and Director of Research and Education at CNS Productions, Inc. in Medford Oregon. Dr. Inaba is a Lifetime Fellow at Haight Ashbury Free Clinics in San Francisco and Associate Clinical Professor of Pharmacy at the University Of California San Francisco School Of Pharmacy. While working at the Haight-Ashbury Clinics, Dr. Inaba supervised the clinical treatment of over 300,000 self-referred substance abusers. He is also noted for his work in developing culturally consistent treatment services with the National Asian Pacific American Families Against Substance Abuse and the Glide Memorial Church's African American Extended Family Recovery Center in San Francisco.
